Can EMIS handle complex prescription order sets such as chemotherapy, dialysis, or complicated IV mixtures?

How can a complex custom prescription mixture be generated in EMIS?

This type of custom mixture is called a LOCAL MIXTURE in the **EMIS Prescribing Module**. It enables physicians to use a percentage of various drug constituents to create a new mixture.

How simple is it to use?

Everything is accomplished by Clicking on the choices presented; only Strength/Quantity requires data entry.

Main Steps include:

- Prescribing Module
- Add Drugs
- Options
- Search Local Mixtures
- Add New Mixture
- Add Constituents
- Type Strength/Quantity

SAVE IT!

Will I have to re-enter it every time?

Once a new mixture is created and saved, it is retained in the Local Mixtures list.
